Videonystagmography (VNG)

Videonystagmography (VNG) is used to test ear for vestibular problems that can affect your balance. Testing will take approximately 1 hour.

Our office requires 48 hour notice for all cancellations and rescheduling. Failure to provide adequate notice will result in a \$50.00 fee per test.

The following medications **MAY NOT BE TAKEN 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE TEST:**

- ANTIHISTAMINES (cold and allergy medications)
- SEDATIVES
- ANTI-DIZZINESS/VERTIGO MEDICATIONS
- PAIN MEDICATIONS (muscle relaxers, narcotics)
- TRANQUILIZERS

PLEASE DO NOT STOP TAKING YOUR BLOOD PRESURE MEDICATIONS. IT IS ACCEPTABLE TO TAKE THIS MEDICATION ON THE DAY OF YOUR TEST.

Please call with any questions regarding your medications.

TO INSURE ACCURATE TESTING, PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING:

- NO ALCOHOL should be consumed 24 hours before test.
- NO NICOTINE should be consumed 24 hours before the test
- NO CAFFEINE should be comsumed 6 hours before the test
- NO FOOD should be consumed 4 hours before the test
- NO MAKEUP (eye makeup in particular)
- DO NOT WEAR CONTACT LENSES
- PLAN TO HAVE SOMEONE DRIVE YOU HOME AFTER THE APPOINTMENT as some patients experience dizziness and are unable to drive.
